How to import MOOC content

The Contemporary Approaches to University Teaching MOOC is now available for you in three formats:

- The full course export from Canvas as an imscc (IMS Common Cartridge[®]) standard file. This can be imported to your Institution's Learning Management System (LMS). For those not using the Canvas LMS, a review of the content structure may be required after import. This correct course structure can be available through the online course or within the HTML format.
- 2. A HTML format (zipped) has been created to host within an LMS or other web service. Note that discussion boards and links to the end of module surveys will not operate in this HTML format.
- 3. An <u>EPUB 3.0</u> is also available for use with EPUB readers.
