Domains of Practice for Benchmarking

In recognition that the mission and core business of ADUs within universities across Australia varies along with their level of maturity as an academic development unit, the approach to benchmarking advocated here is one based on collaborative peer assessment of performance in each of those domains and sub-domains considered relevant to the particular ADU, against performance indicators that reflect different levels of maturity.

Eight key domains of practice have been identified for Academic Development units (ADUs) in Australian universities that might be used to benchmark performance. Each domain is divided into sub-domains. The domains and sub-domains are as follows:
